## A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 30-GA-12

"Expressing the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures' support of and advocating the passage of H.R. 670 by the United States Congress."

WHEREAS, the coastal states and territories of the United States may claim title for jurisdictional and economic purposes to territorial waters extending from their shores under the Submerged Lands Act of 1953 and subsequent acts; and
WHEREAS, with the passage of several submerged lands acts, the U.S. Congress has provided that the coastal states and territories of the United States have a vested interest in the lands beneath navigable waters, and have the right to manage, lease, and develop these lands and

WHEREAS, based on a decision of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals under the Doctrine of Paramountcy, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) currently has no similar claim to territorial waters and the resources therein extending from its shores, see Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands v. United States, 399 F.3d 1057 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2005); and

WHEREAS, the decision of the Ninth Circuit was appealed unsuccessfully to the Supreme Court of the United States; and

WHEREAS, there is pending in the United States Congress a bill, H.R. 670, introduced by CNMI Delegate to the United States Congress Gregorio C. Sablan and co-sponsored by Representative Don Young of Alaska, Guam Delegate to the United States Congress Madeleine Bordallo, Representative Grace Napolitano of California, Resident Commissioner of Puerto Rico to the United States Congress Pedro Pierluisi, Representative Mazie K Hirono of Hawaii, Representative Mike Honda of California, Representative Dan Boren of Oklahoma, Representative Jeff Flake of Arizona, Representative Donna M. Christensen of the Virgin

  - WHEREAS, the unified support of this legislation by the Association of the Pacific Island Legislatures validates the importance of the submerged lands issue to the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; now, therefore,
- BE IT RESOLVED, by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 30<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, Republic of Palau, June 15-17, 2011, that the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures expresses its support and advocates the passage of H.R. 670 by the United States Congress; and
