A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 30-GA-23

“Expressing gratitude and appreciation to the Pacific Islands Development Bank for its contribution to the programs and services of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.”

1 **WHEREAS**, the APIL Board of Directors adopted resolution No. 51-BOD-11, “authorizing the
2 APIL Officers to look to outside sources of funding to help supplement the annual membership
3 contributions to APIL”, and

4 **WHEREAS**, the APIL President forwarded a letter to the management of PIDB to support
5 APIL’s efforts; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the 30th General Assembly of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures was
7 held in the Republic of Palau from June 15-17, 2011; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Pacific Islands Development Bank (PIDB) was present at the General Assembly
9 in the personage of the Bank’s President, Mr. Aren Palik, at which time the PIDB generously donated
10 monetary assistance in the amount of five thousand dollars to help programs and services of the
11 Association of Pacific Island Legislatures; now, therefore,

12 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 30th General Assembly,
13 Republic of Palau, June 15-17, 2011, that the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures hereby expresses

15 Bank’s presence at the 30th General Assembly and hereby further conveys our gratitude to the Bank for its

18 shall attest to the adoption hereof; and that copies of the same shall be thereafter transmitted to the
19 President of the Pacific Islands Development Bank and to the Presiding Legislative Officers and Chief
20 Executives of each of the APIL member jurisdictions.
