A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 36-GA-12

“Urging all member legislative assemblies of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to request the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to provide legislative induction training to Legislatures and Parliaments.”

1 **WHEREAS**, the member legislative assemblies of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures,
2 as members of the United Nations, are cognizant of the assistance available through the United Nations
3 Development Programme (UNDP) especially for developing states; and

4 **WHEREAS**, following the election of the 14th Chuuk State Legislature, the United Nations
5 Development Programme (UNDP) through its partners provided a legislative induction training to each
6 member of the Chuuk State Legislatures, including information of the legislative process and technical
7 assistance and training, which the members of the Chuuk State Legislature, especially the newly elected
8 members, found highly informative and helpful in the pursuit of their legislative endeavors; now,
9 therefore,

10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 36th General Assembly,
11 Christmas Islands, Republic of Kiribati, June 22-24, 2017, that this Assembly hereby urges all member
12 legislative assemblies of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to respectfully request the United
13 Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to provide legislative induction training to each APIL
14 Legislature and Parliament; and

- 1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify and the APIL Secretary
2 shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be transmitted to the United Nations
3 Development Programme (UNDP) office in Suva, Fiji, and be also transmitted to the Legislative Presiding
4 Officers and Chief Executives of each member jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific Island
5 Legislatures.
