A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 37-GA-17

"Respectfully, yet earnestly, requesting all Member Legislative Assemblies of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to continue their support and investment in the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund."

1	WHEREAS, in 2016, the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship
2	Fund was established with seed funding from the estate of the late Bill Raynor to
3	honor his lifetime of conservation work in Micronesia; and
4	WHEREAS, the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund is
5	aimed at supporting the post-secondary educational development of Micronesia's
6	emerging conservation leaders; and
7	WHEREAS, the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund is
8	administered and managed by the Micronesia Conservation Trust which also
9	administers and manages the Micronesia Challenge Endowment Fund; and
10	WHEREAS, since its inception, a total of over \$600,000 have been raised
11	for the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund from public and
12	private contributions due to the fundraising efforts of the Micronesia Conservation
13	Trust and other partners; and
14	WHEREAS, a U.S. based donor has agreed to match 1:1 for every dollar
15	that is raised from our own governments and local entities; and

WHEREAS, the goal is to build an endowment of approximately 16

\$1,200,000 that will sustain the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship

WHEREAS, to date, four Micronesian students from member jurisdictions 1 2 of the APIL are enrolled in universities in the United States and in Japan and are 3 benefiting from the Bill Raynor Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund; and 4 WHEREAS, four additional students have been selected from member jurisdictions of the APIL to receive financial support from this scholarship fund 5 starting in the Fall of 2018; now, therefore, 6 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 37th 7 8 General Assembly, FSM State of Pohnpei, June 26 – 29, 2018, that, in line with 9 our tradition of supporting the educational development of our island people, the 10 Association of Pacific Island Legislatures hereby respectfully, yet earnestly, requests all Member Legislative Assemblies of the Association of Pacific Island 11 12 Legislatures to continue their support and investment in the Bill Raynor 13 Micronesia Challenge Scholarship Fund; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify and 14 the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same 15 shall be thereafter transmitted to the Presiding Legislative Officers and Chief 16 17 Executives of each of the member jurisdictions of the APIL and to the Micronesia 18 Conservation Trust to share with its partners, donors and contributors.
