A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 39-GA-11

"Extending deepest and most sincere congratulations to the Honorable Aren B. Palik on your election to the Office of the Ninth Vice-President of the Federated States of Micronesia."

1	WHEREAS, the Honorable Aren B. Palik, the newly elected Vice-President of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia, came to this esteemed public office with a notable academic
3	background in finances, having graduated with honors from University of Delaware, Stonies
4	Graduate School of Banking; and
5	WHEREAS, throughout his career in the field of finance, the Honorable Vice-
6	President Palik held many positions of fiscal responsibility from Planner and Economist for
7	the Kosrae State, to serving as the Vice-President of the FSM Development Bank and later
8	holding positions of considerable importance in the FSM Commercial Bank, the Bank of
9	Hawaii and most recently the Pacific Islands Development Bank; and
10	WHEREAS, we are especially proud of the Honorable Vice-President Palik's service
11	as President and CEO of the Pacific Islands Development Bank as this Pacific-wide financial
12	institution can trace its foundational roots to the pioneering efforts of the Association of Pacific
13	Island Legislatures itself; and
14	WHEREAS, in 2019, the Honorable Aren B. Palik was elected by the citizens of
15	the FSM State of Kosrae to serve as their four-year representative in the 21st and 22nd
16	Congresses of the Federated States of Micronesia where he held the positions of Vice Chair or
17	both the Congressional Committee on Education and the Congressional Committee or
18	Resources & Development; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, following the tragic death of the late Honorable Vice President Yosiwo P. George who had fallen victim to the COVID-19 pandemic and following the decision of the 22nd Congress to fill the vacancy in the late Vice-President's

1 position, FSM Congress Senator Aren B. Palik of the State of Kosrae, was sworn in as the

2 Ninth Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia, an event that was witnessed both

3 by national and state officials gathered at the swearing in ceremony at the capitol grounds in

4 Palikir and by viewers here and around the world via the internet; and

5 WHEREAS, those of us in the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures find

6 inspiration in the delivery of his acceptance address for the second highest public office in the

7 FSM Government where the newly sworn—in Vice-President proclaimed, "as a public servant,

8 and we are all public servants, we must be prepared to sacrifice and do our part to ensure

unity in our nation for a smooth and uninterrupted operation in our government."; now,
