A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No.40-GA-16

"Encouraging members of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to join the Pacific Islands Parliament Group."

WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures is comprised of twelve members: American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the four States of the Federated States of Micronesia (Chuuk, Kosrae, Pohnpei, and Yap), the U.S. Territory of Guam, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Republic of Palau, the State of Hawaii, the Republic of Kiribati, and the Republic of Nauru; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Islands Parliament Group is comprised of eighteen members, which include the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures members of American Samoa, the State of Hawaii, and the Republic of Palau; and

WHEREAS, both organizations share a similar mission and vision to promote unity among island legislatures and the governments of the Pacific to tackle the pressing issues facing the Pacific Islands; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Islands Parliament Group has the goals to participate in the promotion of Pacific identity, culture and language; to contribute to a better knowledge of the functioning of the representative institutions and the strengthening and development of their means of action; to promote the role of Gender Equity in Pacific institutions; and to discuss issues of common interest; and

WHEREAS, regional cooperation is essential to the Blue Economy and support for the projects of APIL member jurisdictions, such as Palau's marine spatial planning initiative and the Federated States of Micronesia's Blue Prosperity Micronesia, and is vital for economic growth and preservation of natural resources in the Pacific; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Islands Parliament Group meets each year to discuss common issues and share their knowledge and experiences to create a Blue Economy Knowledge Hub; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of Palau has been honored with the responsibility to organize and host the 2024 Pacific Islands Parliament Group conference; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of Palau would be pleased to host members of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures that choose to join the Pacific Islands Parliament Group; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 40th
General Assembly, FSM State of Chuuk, October 18-20, 2023, that the
Association of Pacific Island Legislatures hereby encourages members of the
Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to join the Pacific Islands Parliament
Group; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify and the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same shall be thereafter transmitted to the Chief Executive and Legislative Presiding Officers of each member jurisdiction of the APIL.
