## **A RESOLUTION**

## APIL Resolution No. 42-GA-02

"Establishing a special committee within the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to assess and recommend lowering the rising cost of fuel in APIL member states."

WHEREAS, the cost of fuel across Association of Pacific Island Legislatures 1 2 (APIL) member states in the Pacific region has significantly increased, affecting transportation, food security, energy generation, and the cost of living for island 3 4 communities; and WHEREAS, APIL member states are particularly vulnerable to global price 5 6 fluctuations due to their geographic isolation, dependence on imported petroleum products, and limited economies of scale; and 7 WHEREAS, fluctuating fuel prices have direct and disproportionate impacts on 8 local economies, government budgets, and the delivery of essential public services; and 9 10 WHEREAS, collaboration and shared research are necessary to better understand the root causes of high fuel costs and to identify sustainable, long-term strategies to 11 12 mitigate their impact; and WHEREAS, APIL, as a regional legislative body, is uniquely positioned to 13 14 15

coordinate joint study and advocacy efforts to seek solutions, including alternative energy development, bulk purchasing strategies, and improved transportation logistics; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures that there is hereby established a Special Committee on Fuel Costs and Energy Security composed of representatives from Member States, tasked to:

- 1. Assess and document current fuel pricing structures and contributing factors across Member States;
- 2. Examine options for APIL cooperation in bulk purchasing, shipping logistics, and storage;

- 3. Explore alternative and renewable energy options suited to small island economies;
  - 4. Consult with regional and international organizations on strategies to stabilize or reduce fuel costs;
  - 5. Assess best options for APIL members to reduce fuel prices; and
  - 6. Submit findings and recommendations to the APIL Board of Directors for further action and possible legislative proposals.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 42nd General Assembly on Saipan, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, October 28-29, 2025, that the members of the Association of the Pacific Island Legislatures, hereby establishes a special committee within the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to assess and recommend lowering the rising cost of fuel in APIL member states; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify, and the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be thereafter transmitted to the Chief Executive and Legislative Presiding Officers of each member of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
