## **A RESOLUTION**

**APIL Resolution No. 42-GA-06** 

"A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION OF PACIFIC ISLAND LEGISLATURES TO ESTABLISH AND APPOINT MEMBERS TO A TASKFORCE ON NUCLEAR FALLOUT IMPACT AND REGIONAL ADVOCACY."

WHEREAS, Pacific Island communities, including the Marshall Islands, 1 Guam, and other Micronesian regions, continue to face the lasting health, 2 environmental, and social effects of nuclear fallout from past testing activities; and 3 WHEREAS, recent discussions have highlighted the need to ensure that all 4 directly and potentially affected areas are included in ongoing reviews and 5 compensation initiatives under the United States' nuclear claims programs; and 6 WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures (APIL) recognizes 7 the importance of gathering accurate information and coordinating regional advocacy 8 to ensure that all affected Pacific peoples are fairly represented and supported; now, 9 therefore, 10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 42<sup>nd</sup> 11 General Assembly on Saipan, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, 12 October 28-29, 2025, that the President of APIL shall establish and appoint members 13 to a Taskforce on Nuclear Impact and Regional Advocacy, to coordinate information-14 sharing, research, and unified engagement with the U.S. Government and relevant 15 partners; and 16

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify, and
- 2 the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same
- 3 shall thereafter be transmitted to the Chief Executives and Presiding Legislative Officers
- 4 of each member jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
