A RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 51-BOD-02

"Complimenting and recognizing the Center for Micronesian Empowerment (CME) for taking the lead in empowering the underserved by providing the job skills training needs, coordinating training activities with various institutions in Guam in preparation for the military build-up."

1 WHEREAS, the Center for Micronesian Empowerment (CME) is a non-profit 2 organization dedicated to empowering the underserved by providing the necessary skills they need to succeed on the job; and 3 WHEREAS, CME's existence is timely and appropriate to assist and provide job 4 training skills needed by Micronesians to enter the workforce and supply homegrown 5 labor to meet the Guam Military Build-up workforce; and 6 WHEREAS, the Military Build-up promises long term and secure job 7 opportunities for the citizens of Micronesia today and the next generation to come; and 8 WHEREAS, after the Military Build-up is complete, the skills that CME has 9 provided to the underserved will present a lifetime career to Micronesians, which will 10 positively impact upon their lives in Guam and their home island countries; and 11 WHEREAS, the Military build-up will contribute tremendously to the economy 12 of each of the Micronesian island States directly and indirectly through economic 13 development sectors such as agriculture, tourism, infrastructure, and other goods and 14 services production; now, therefore, 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific 16 Island Legislatures, 51st Board Meeting, December 1-3, 2010, Colonia, Yap, Federated 17 States of Micronesia, that the Board of Directors, on behalf of the Association of Pacific 18 Island Legislatures, hereby compliments and recognizes the Center for Micronesian 19 Empowerment (CME) for taking the lead in empowering the underserved by providing 20
