## **A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the member entities of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures can singularly and collectively encourage the private sector in its respective countries or states to encourage free trade by putting forth appropriate and respective policies and legislations; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 51<sup>st</sup> Board Meeting, December 1-3, 2010, Colonia, Yap, Federated States of Micronesia, that the Board of Directors on behalf of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures hereby encourages all member States of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures to enter into negotiations and dialogues, issue policies and legislation, and facilitate and promote free trade throughout Micronesian and Pacific Regions; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that APIL President shall certify, and the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be thereafter transmitted to the Chief Executives and Legislative Presiding Officers of each member legislature of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
