## A RESOLUTION

### APIL Resolution No. 51-BOD-06

**“Requesting the Digital Society Foundation to explore possibilities for improving the delivery of Legislative services in the area of information and communication technology and to better serve the Legislatures in fulfilling and strengthening their oversight and Legislative functions in the APIL and authorizing Digital Society Foundation to seek funding from the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), Pacific Islands Forum, World Bank and other funding bodies on behalf of the APIL for such projects.”**

1           **WHEREAS**, Digital Society Foundation has been formed to assist developing communities  
2   gain social and economic benefits from digital-age Information and Communications Technologies  
3   (ICT); and

4           **WHEREAS**, the APIL formed a sister organization partnership with the Digital Society  
5   Foundation to assist APIL member entities with Information and Communication Technology; now,  
6   therefore,

7           **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island  
8   Legislatures, 51<sup>st</sup> Board Meeting, December 1-3, 2010, Colonia, Yap, Federated States of  
9   Micronesia, that the Board of Directors, on behalf of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures,  
10   hereby requests Digital Society Foundation to explore possibilities for improving the delivery of  
11   Legislative services in the areas of information and communication technology and to better serve  
12   the Legislatures in fulfilling and strengthening their oversight and Legislative functions in the APIL  
13   and authorizing Digital Society Foundation to seek funding sources from the United Nations  
14   Development Program (UNDP), Pacific Islands Forum, World Bank and other funding bodies on  
15   behalf of the APIL for such projects; and

1           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify, and the APIL  
2 Secretary shall attest, to the adoption of this resolution and that copies of the same shall be  
3 thereafter transmitted to the President and CEO of Digital Society Foundation and to the Chief  
4 Executives and Legislative Presiding Officers of each member legislature of the Association of  
5 Pacific Island Legislatures.
