A RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 53-BOD-08

"Relative to the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures' expressed support and advocacy for assessing and addressing Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs)."

1 WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures (APIL) has consistently 2 advocated for lawmakers and executives to act on the need to establish prevention programs aimed at improving the health of island peoples; and 3 WHEREAS, APIL strongly acknowledges that a strategic plan that is actionable, 4 5 inclusive, data driven, and capable of achieving success and with substantial impact upon the 6 targeted population requires a collaborative funded effort involving both the government and private volunteer organizations, civic organizations, and those whose research and vocation 7 is in a related field; and 8 WHEREAS, APIL lauds the efforts of the Ayuda Foundation for identifying funding 9 10 and partnering opportunities geared to mitigate the epidemic of Non-Communicable Diseases among Pacific island peoples; now, therefore, 11 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 53rd Board of 12 Directors Meeting, December 5-6, 2012, State of Pohnpei, FSM, that the Board of Directors 13 14 on behalf of the APIL, hereby expresses its endorsement of the Ayuda Foundation's grant 15 Request for Technical Assistance as addressed to the Office of Insular Affairs; and
