A RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 53-BOD-19

"Expressing the sincerest condolences of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures for the untimely passing of the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham, Speaker of the Tenth Kosrae Legislature."

1	WHEREAS, on the first day of November in the Year of Our Lord, 2012, the
2	late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham, a prominent leader of the State of Kosrae and
3	respected statesman throughout Micronesia, was called by his Heavenly Father to his
4	eternal rest; and
5	WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham is survived by his wife,
6	Mrs. Mesalina Abraham; children; Yoshiro Abraham, Lyndon Abraham Jr., Brucetole
7	Abraham, Mayleen Abraham, Osamu Abraham and his many grandchildren; and
8	WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon Abraham served in official capacities
9	in the former Trust Territory Administration and in the constitutional governments of
0	the FSM, where he held many offices of importance involving the finances and
11	administration of our developing governments; and
12	WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham also shared his
13	considerable financial expertise with the private sector where he held posts of
14	responsibility and importance within the banking community; and
15	WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was a delegate of the First
16	Kosrae Constitutional Convention and was also the Chairman of the Committee on

Finance and Taxation for the convention; and

1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was once again elected as 2 a delegate to the Third Kosrae Constitutional Convention and was also the president for 3 that convention; and 4 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was dedicated to the 5 education of the youth of Micronesia and served as a member of the Board of Regents 6 of the College of Micronesia, FSM; and 7 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was also a dedicated 8 church member and contributed much to the moral upbringing of the youth of Kosrae; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, in 1991, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was elected by 11 the people of Kosrae to serve as the Lt. Governor until 1995; and 12 WHEREAS, after serving in several other official capacities in public service, 13 the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was most recently elected by the people of 14 Kosrae to serve in the Tenth Kosrae Legislature where he served as the Speaker until 15 his untimely passing; and 16 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham was an active participant 17 in the General Assemblies of the Association of the Pacific Islands Legislatures and was 18 serving on APIL's Board of Directors at the time of his untimely passing; and 19 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham dedicated most of his life 20 to the betterment of the people of his island and the people of Micronesia; and 21 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Lyndon B. Abraham will greatly be missed; 22 now, therefore; 23 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 53rd 24 Board of Directors meeting, December 5-6, 2012, State of Pohnpei, FSM, that the Board of Directors of the APIL do hereby express the sincerest condolences of the 25
