A RESOLUTION

“Requesting United Airlines to increase air service for the State of Yap.”

1 **WHEREAS**, United Airlines has only two flights a week serving the State of Yap in the
2 Federated States of Micronesia; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the tourism industry in the State of Yap is heavily reliant on assured, consistent and
4 frequent flight services to fully develop and stabilize the local economy by virtue of its geographic and
5 economical configuration, and the lack thereof is seriously hindering the progress and potential of the
6 Yap’s tourism industry; and


7 **WHEREAS**, it is within the responsibility of this august body to assist the member entities,
8 especially in such areas where a collective voice is warranted; now, therefore,

9 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, Fifty-Fifth Board of
10 Directors Meeting, State of Yap, December 3-5, 2014, that the Board of Directors of the Association of
11 Pacific Island Legislatures, for and on behalf of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, hereby
12 requests United Airlines to increase air service for the State of Yap; and

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify, and the APIL Secretary
14 shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall thereafter be transmitted to the Chief
15 Executive Officer of United Airlines, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and to the Chief
16 Executives and Presiding Legislative Officers of each member jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific
17 Island Legislatures.
