A RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 56-BOD-05

"Respectfully requesting assistance of the Asian Development Bank in providing grant funding for an actuarial study on the feasibility of a regional health insurance plan for the peoples of the Freely Associated States, namely the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia and the Republic of Palau."

WHEREAS, the 34th General Assembly of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 1 2 which was held on the Island of Pohnpei in July 2015, adopted Resolution No. 34-GS-17, L.D. 1 in which this Association expressed our need to obtain funding for an actuarial study on the feasibility 3 of a regional health insurance plan which will identify in detail: (1) administration and governance; 4 (2) benefits package and limitations; (3) financing and pricing based on actuarial analysis; (4) 5 participation of APIL member states; (5) sustainability; (6) potential next steps for broadening a 6 supplemental regional health insurance plan into a regional accountable care organization; (7) 7 8 exploring the potentiality of a universal health care system; and (8) portability; and 9 WHEREAS, the adoption of the resolution by the General Assembly of the APIL in July of 2015 was a continuation of the efforts of APIL to foster and promote the establishment of a regional 10 health insurance plan that will be portable and will incorporate advanced medical care for all APIL 11 member states and territories if not all the jurisdictions that constitute the Blue Continent; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 34-GA-17, L.D. 1 was transmitted to the United States Ambassadors to the Freely Associated States to formally communicate the General Assembly's 14 request to the United States Department of the Interior, Office of Insular Affairs, to seek the 15 16 Department's assistance in funding the actuarial study; but

WHEREAS, unfortunately, this effort to obtain financial assistance from the U.S.

Department of the Interior in financing the required actuarial study was not successful; however 2

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Directors of the Association of 3

Pacific Island Legislatures that the necessary financial support might be forth coming through the 4

progressive and socially supportive funding opportunities of the Asian Development Bank; now,

therefore,

Micronesia and the Republic of Palau; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify, and the APIL

Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be transmitted to the

President of the Asian Development Bank and to the Chief Executives and the Legislative Presiding

Officers of each member jurisdiction of the Association of the Pacific Island Legislatures.
