## A RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 57-BOD-06

"Expressing the sincere appreciation of the Board of Directors of the Association of the Pacific Island Legislatures to the Parliament of the Republic of Kiribati on the passage of Shark Sanctuary legislation thereby completing the map of the largest and most comprehensive Shark Sanctuary in the world."

- WHEREAS, the Government of the Republic of Kiribati recently enacted
- 2 legislation establishing the Kiribati Shark Sanctuary; and
- WHEREAS, the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the US
- 4 Territory of Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, the Federated
- 5 States of Micronesia and its four states have all passed laws protecting sharks in their
- 6 waters as well; and
- WHEREAS, the passage of the Kiribati Shark Law has ultimately led to the
- 8 completion of the Micronesian Shark Sanctuary which is protecting an ocean area larger
- 9 than the mainland of the United States of America; now, therefore,
- 10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island
- Legislatures, 57th Board Meeting, State of Chuuk, December 8-9, 2016, that this Board
- of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures hereby expresses our sincere
- appreciation to the Parliament of the Republic of Kiribati on the passage of the Shark
- Sanctuary legislation thereby completing the map of the largest and most comprehensive
- 15 Shark Sanctuary in the world; and

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify, and the
- 2 APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be
- 3 transmitted to the Chief Executives and Presiding Legislative Officers of each member
- 4 jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
