APIL Resolution No. 62-BOD-05

"Expressing, on behalf of the Association of Pacific Island Legislature, congratulations to the newly elected and returning Governors in the FSM, the US State of Hawaii, Island of Guam, and CNMI following the November elections and extending our heartfelt wishes and appreciations to those who will be departing for their great services."

1 WHEREAS, perhaps the most enduring of all traditions associated with the democratic governments throughout the APIL Pacific is the election process; and 2 WHEREAS, on no other day in our careers as elected leaders are we more atuned 3 to the needs and aspirations of our people than on Election Day; and 4 WHEREAS the message that our people present to us on Election Day 5 reverberates throughout our entire terms as leaders; and 6 WHEREAS, the message that our electors impart upon us is a humbling one; we 7 are their servants for whom we have been accorded not only the privilege, but also the 8 mandate to speak for them in the public forums and in the halls of government; and 9 WHEREAS, in November of 2022, the voters of the FSM States of Yap and 10 Kosrae, the US State of Hawaii, the Island of Guam, and the CNMI took to the polls to

WHEREAS, these elections resulted in the election of the Honorable Charles Chieng as Governor of the FSM State of Yap, the Honorable Tulensa W. Palik of the FSM State of Kosrae, the Honorable Josh Green of the US State of Hawaii, the Honorable Lou Leon Guerrero of the Island of Guam, and the Honorable Arnold Palacios of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and

vote for their Governors to serve in their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, these elections endowed the successful candidates with new visions and new directives for how their administrations will address not only the executive challenges of their own islands, but also the challenges of economic development,

- 9 APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be
- transmitted to each of the Governors of the FSM States of Yap and Kosrae, the US State
- of Hawaii, the Island of Guam, and the CNMI; and to the Presiding Legislative Officers
- of each member jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
