A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 62-BOD-09

"Respectfully requesting United Airlines to restore the week-end 'turn-around' flight schedule which originates in Guam and travels to Chuuk, then to Pohnpei, and thereafter returns to Guam with a second stop-over in Chuuk."

1 WHEREAS, United Airlines is the principle international airline carrier servicing the islands of Micronesia, having inherited a long and proud legacy of the airline 2 industry's efforts to pioneer air transportation to, from and between the island 3 destinations of the APIL Pacific; and 4 WHEREAS, these airline services have become central to the economic viability 5 of our islands and the health and welfare of our people; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the APIL is especially thankful to United Airlines which continued to provide essential air services to the region throughout the most troublesome times of 8 the COVID pandemic; and 9 WHEREAS, with the diminishment of the dangers of the COVID pandemic to air 10 travel, it was hoped that United Airlines would restore the full schedule of its air services 11 12 to the islands of Micronesia; however WHEREAS, one of the most popular schedules of the recent past was the week-13 end 'turn around' flight that would originate in Guam and travel to Chuuk, then to 14 Pohnpei, and then return to Guam with a second stop-over in Chuuk; and 15

WHEREAS, islanders who frequently travel between these islands for both business and family matters have become dependent on this particular flight pattern to maintain cost effective and practical inter-island travel; and

WHEREAS, islanders traveling to the U.S. Mainland and Asian destinations have also found this particular flight schedule to be cost effective and practical as the timing of this flight schedule allows for convenient plane transfers in Guam to United

- Airlines flights departing to destinations abroad without an expensive layover on the
- 2 island of Guam, now, therefore,
- 3 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific
- 4 Island Legislatures, 62nd Board Meeting, FSM State of Kosrae, April 5-6, 2023, that the
- 5 Board of Directors, on behalf of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, hereby
- 6 respectfully requests United Airlines to restore the week-end 'turn-around' flight
- schedule which originates in Guam and travels to Chuuk, then to Pohnpei, and thereafter
- 8 returns to Guam with a second stop-over in Chuuk; and
- 9 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify, and the
- 10 APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same
- shall be thereafter transmitted to the Chief Executives and Legislative Presiding Officers
- of each member jurisdiction of the APIL.
