WHEREAS, in November of 2022, the voters of the FSM State of Kosrae took
 the polls to vote for their legislative members to service in their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, the election resulted in the historic selection of the Honorable
Ruthsina R. Jonah, becoming the first ever female Senator to serve in the Legislative
Assembly of the FSM State of Kosrae; and
