A RESOLUTION

APIL Resolution No. 63-BOD-09

“Calling on the Board of Directors to create a temporary *ad hoc* committee from members of the APIL for the purpose of reviewing and prioritizing the resolutions adopted in previous Board of the Directors meetings and General Assemblies of the APIL.”

1 **WHEREAS**, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures have had regular
2 meetings for the Board of Directors and General Assemblies since its inception in 1981, a
3 little over forty years ago, with numerous resolutions having been adopted by this body over
4 said years; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the APIL participants are everchanging, dependent on elections,
6 appointments and selections, often with newer members not aware of the previous efforts
7 and intents; and


8 **WHEREAS**, with a multitude of topics and foci of adopted APIL resolutions, there
9 is a need to enable a working group to organize, regroup and prioritize efforts to avoid
10 repetition and to streamline the process; now, therefore,

11 **BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island
12 Legislatures, 63rd Board of Directors meeting, State of Yap, the Federated States of
13 Micronesia, February 25 - March 02, 2024, that the APIL Board of Directors is hereby
14 creating a temporary *ad hoc* committee from members of the APIL for the purpose of
15 reviewing and prioritizing the resolutions adopted in previous Board of the Directors
16 meetings and General Assemblies of the APIL; and

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the members of said committee will be
2 decided by the presiding officer of the 63rd Board of Directors meeting with instructions
3 that they must report back in the 64th Board of Directors meeting, wherever and whenever
4 it may be held; and

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that APIL President shall certify, and the APIL
6 Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be thereafter
7 transmitted to the Chief Executives and Presiding Legislative Officers of each of the
8 member jurisdictions of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
