## A RESOLUTION

## **APIL Resolution No. 64-BOD-01**

"Respectfully calling on the Board of Directors to establish an Ad Hoc Committee to review the By-Laws and the Rules of Procedure of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures."

1	WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures (APIL or Association)
2	By-Laws, inclusive of the Rules of Procedure, were officially adopted to establish the rules
3	governing the operations of this esteemed body; and
4	WHEREAS, the most recent amendment to the APIL By-Laws was made on
5	December 2, 2005; and
6	WHEREAS, since 2005, a number of resolutions have been duly adopted by the
7	Board of Directors during their annual meetings, as well as by the members present at the
8	annual General Assembly, which amend the duties and responsibilities of this Association;
9	however, these changes have not yet been reflected in the By-Laws; and
10	WHEREAS, it is crucial for the APIL By-Laws to be reviewed in order to
11	incorporate all resolutions adopted since 2005, ensuring that the operations and objectives
12	of this Association align with the intentions of past, current, and future members of this
13	respected body; and
14	WHEREAS, during the 63 <sup>rd</sup> Board of Directors Meeting, it became clear that the
15	procedures for conducting the Board of Directors Meeting differ from those of the General
16	Assembly, that raised several concerns about how this august body should proceed with its
17	operations in the future; and

WHEREAS, the APIL By-Laws are essential for maintaining order and providing

direction to the members of this Association, recognizing that membership is dependent on

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specific appointments and transitions in legislative leadership after elections within our island jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS,** after nearly two decades since the last amendment, a comprehensive review and update to the By-Laws is necessary to address the needs of this Association as a unified voice of the Blue Continent; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Association of Pacific Island
Legislatures, 64<sup>th</sup> Board of Directors meeting, Majuro, Republic of the Marshall Islands,
February 25-26, 2025, that the APIL Board of Directors hereby establishes an Ad Hoc
Committee to review the APIL By-Laws and the Rules of Procedure; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Ad Hoc Committee shall consist of no more than five members and one alternate member, appointed by the APIL President, to report their findings and recommendations at the 42<sup>nd</sup> General Assembly; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the APIL President shall certify and the APIL Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be thereafter transmitted to the Chief Executives and Legislative Presiding Officers of each member jurisdiction of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
