"Establishing a sister organization partnership between the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures and the Digital Society Foundation."

WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures wishes to form a sister organization partnership with the Digital Society Foundation, to assist APIL member states with Information & Communication Technology (ICT); and

WHEREAS, there is a gap between government ICT programs, current NGO programs and the commercial ICT sectors; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, 29th General Assembly, Tarawa, Republic of Kiribati, June 3-4, 2010, that the APIL hereby establishes a sister organization partnership with Digital Society Foundation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Executive Officer of the Digital Society Foundation respectfully reports to the APIL on projects and programs that are being planned and that have been implemented by the Foundation to promote the development of Information and Communication Technology in the APIL region of the Pacific; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the APIL President shall certify and the Secretary shall attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of the same shall be transmitted to the Digital Society Foundation and to the chief executives and presiding legislative officers of each member of the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures.
